My family research on immigrants from central Europe to North Carolina via Pennsylvania in the mid-18th century, divided into two parts. The two stories are quite different, as the families emigrated from different places at different times and under different circumstances. They met in Pennsylvania, before moving together to North Carolina in the 1760s. Moreover, the methods I used for discovering their home village origins were quite different, as were the experiences encountered when visiting each place a few years ago.
