ANNUAL FALL MEETING, SATURDAY, OCTOBER 23, 1982

Ohio Chapter, Palatines to America will hold the annual Fall meeting on Saturday, October 23, 1982, at the Ohio Historical Center Auditorium from 8:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. The featured speaker will be Clifford Neal Smith, author of Encyclopedia of German-American Genealogical Resources in German Archives, and numerous monographs on German soldiers in the Revolutionary War, emigration from Germany, and U.S. land records.

Registration will be in the lobby of the auditorium from 8:30 to 9:15 a.m. Before 9:00 entrance must be through the doors on the west side of the building near the auditorium. Those parking in the east lot will need to come around the walkway surrounding the museum and down the rear stairway to enter the west doors.

Parking charge is \$2.00, but free to OHS members, so don't forget to bring your OHS membership card. If you should choose to join the Ohio Historical Society at the time of parking, the \$2.00 will be credited toward your membership fee.

Following the call to order, announcements and presentation of a book donation to the OHS, Mr. Smith will speak from 9:30 to 10:30 on "Land Records in the Northwest Territory" and from 10:45 to 11:45 on "Hessian Soldiers in America". Questions from the audience will be welcome.

Following the luncheon break from 12 until 1:30 p.m., Mr. Smith will present

a talk, accompanied by slides, on "Tracing the Germans back to Pennsylvania and/or the Palatinate," continuing until 4 p.m., with a fifteen minute break at 2:30 p.m.

Advance registration fees will be \$6.00 for Palatines to America members and \$8.00 for non-members. At the door, fees will be \$7.50 and \$10.00. Luncheon reservations (optional) for an additional cost at the Colonel Crawford Inn in the adjacent Ohio Village must be made by Saturday, October 16, 1982. Turkey, dressing, vegetable, salad and beverage is \$5.00, including tax and gratuity; Colonial salad and beverage is also \$5.00, including tax and gratuity. CLIFFORD NEAL SMITH, FALL MEETING SPEAKER

The outstanding genealogist, Clifford Neal Smith, who will be our Fall meeting speaker, has devoted many years to lecturing and writing on a myriad of genealogy subjects.

He has been especially interested in research of immigration (17th-19th centuries) from Great Britain and Central Europe (mainly Germany). He is also interested in U.S. land records, colonial, federal and state.

In the dozens of books he has authored many discuss emigrants from various parts of Germany to other countries, others research German mercenaries who remained in America after the Revolution and there is also research on ship passenger lists.
